First annual Hudson River distance race

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The organizing authority is the Nyack Boat Club.

2. RULES

The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. Sailing instructions will be available on the NBC website and at registration. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will prevail, this modifies RRS 63.7.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The race is open to all members of HRYRA that have a current HRYRA or YRA-LIS PHRF certificate. There will be two divisions, spinnaker and non-spinnaker. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, to Eric Kent, at the below address. Late entries will be accepted during registration. All entries must provide a cell phone number on the registration form, so that the race committee may contact you if you can not be raised by VHF radio

4. ENTRY FEE

If the entry form is postmarked by October 8, the entry fee is \$15. For entries postmarked after October 8 or at registration the entry fee is \$30. If not a US Sailing member, there is an additional \$5 fee.

6. VENUE

The racing area will be the part of the Hudson River between Piermont and Stony Point. The start and finish will be near the Nyack Boat Club.

7. THE COURSES

The courses are specified in the Sailing Instructions. The courses will be between 15 and 26 nm.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

The Scoring Penalty, rule 44.3, will apply. The penalty will be 20% of the number of boats registered as indicated in 44.3 (c).

9. SCORING

The race will use the Time on Time PHRF scoring.

10. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to the top 2 boats in each division.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
