Notice of Race

1. Rules

1.1. This event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the 2018j HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions, and the Nyack Boat Club Last Chance Regatta Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Racing classes will be HRYRA PHRF Divisions 1, 2, and 3. All racers must be members of HRYRA and have a current HRYRA or YRALIS PHRF certificate.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may register online at http://www.nyackboatclub.org/last-chance or by registering at the clubhouse between 0800 and 1000 on October 6.

3. FEES

- 3.1. Fees include: trophies, coffee and bagels Saturday and Sunday morning; after Saturday racing there will be beer, snacks and Chowder Feast. Beer and snacks after Sunday racing.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. Saturday, Oct. 6th.

Two or more races scheduled Skippers Meeting: 0930 hrs Warning Signal, 1st Race: 1100 hrs

4.2. Sunday, Oct. 7th.

One or more races scheduled Warning Signal, 1st Race: 1030 hrs No warning signal after 1330 hrs

5. MEASUREMENTS

5.1. Each boat shall have a currently valid PHRF certificate issued by HRYRA or by YRALIS.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1. The sailing instructions will be available by October 4th. at www.nyackboatclub.org. Hard copies will available at registration on October 6th.
- 6.2. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will prevail, changing RRS 63.7.

7. VENUE

7.1. The racing area will be that part of the Hudson River known as the Tappan Zee, south of Hook Mountain and north of the Tappan Zee Bridge.

8. THE COURSES

8.1. The courses to be sailed will be printed in the Sailing Instructions.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1. The Scoring Penalty will apply as described in the HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions, 14.

10. SCORING & PRIZES

- 10.1. The regatta will be scored with no throw outs.
- 10.2. Awards will be made to the skippers placing first, second, and third in each class.

11. MOORINGS

11.1. A A limited number of guest moorings are available. Please request a mooring through Dockwa https://dockwa.com/explore/destination/pwcvx-nyack-boat-club. If it shows no moorings available sign up using the Waitlist and we will make every effort to assign you a mooring. Good anchoring is available to the north of the Club. The NBC Launch Schedule monitors VHF channel 9.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1. Racers shall monitor VHF channel 78 for communications from the Race Committee.
- 12.2. Except in an emergency or notification to the Race Committee, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions while racing that are not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1. Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE

14.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
