135th ANNUAL OPEN HRYRA REGATTA

Saturday & Sunday, September 7th & 8th, 2019

** NOTICE OF RACE **

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The <u>HRYRA 2019 Common Sailing Instructions</u> (referenced subsequently as CSI) will be incorporated in the regatta Sailing Instructions and contain some modifications to the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all cruising classes that have a PHRF rating issued by HRYRA or YRALIS. There will be 3 classes as defined in CSI 6.1 (2 spinnaker depending on PHRF, and 1 non-spinnaker, all PHRFs.)
- 2.2. The Shattemuc racing page at http://www.shattemucyc.org/activities/racing will have links to on-line registration forms, which indicate how to make payment on line by credit card.
- 2.3. Registrations must be received by 1800 Sept. 6, or completed at the club on September 7th, 0900-1000.
- 2.4. Late registrations may be accepted by the Race Committee at its discretion.

3. FEES

- 3.1. \$75 for US Sailing Members, \$80 others; add \$5 if registering after 1800, September 6. Included: 2 regatta dinner reservations, use of pool for crew when open, free overnight berth.
- 3.2. Additional reservations for the Regatta Dinner on Saturday after racing, are \$20 pp (\$10 under 12 yrs); or \$24 pp (\$12 under 12 yrs) if made after Sept. 6. Reservations may be made on the registration form.
- 3.3. Mailed checks for on-line registrations must be received by Sept 5, or be hand-delivered on Sat., Sept. 7.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Two (2) Races are scheduled for Saturday, first warning signal at 1100; and two (2) races for Sunday, first warning signal at 1030.
- 4.2. For each class, the second race each day will be started as soon as practical after the last finisher of the class's previous race. Multiple sound signals and a VHF announcement will be made prior to the second race's warning signal.

5. MEASUREMENTS

5.1. Each boat shall have a currently valid PHRF certificate issued by HRYRA or by YRALIS.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Copies of the regatta Sailing Instructions will be available by September 7 at the HRYRA web site and on the Shattemuc racing page (link in 2.2 above). Please download and print your own copy. To protect the environment, only a few will be printed and available at the club.

7. VENUE

7.1. The racing area will be the waters of the Hudson River in the vicinity of Croton Point.

8. THE COURSES

- 8.1. The starting area will be on the Hudson River within 2 n.m, and usually south, of Croton Point.
- 8.2. Courses are listed in the Sailing Instructions.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1. The Scoring Penalty will apply as described in CSI 14.

10. SCORING & PRIZES

- 10.1. The regatta will be scored with no throw outs, using time-on-time correction as indicated in CSI 17.
- 10.2. Awards will be made to the skippers and crew placing first, second, and third in each class.

11.BERTHING

11.1. Slips accommodating boats up to 7 foot draft and moorings are available for Friday and Saturday night at no charge for yachts registered for the regatta. Please use DOCKWA to make a reservation for a free berth for your boat following the instructions on the on-line registration form.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1. Racers shall monitor VHF channel 69 for communications from the Race Committee.
- 12.2. Except in an emergency or notification to the Race Committee, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions while racing that are not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

13.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk: See Racing Rule 4, "Decision to Race". Shattemuc Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
