Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. This event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the 2022 HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions, and the Nyack Boat Club Last Chance Regatta Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Racing classes will be HRYRA PHRF Divisions 1, 2, and 3. All racers must be members of HRYRA and have a current HRYRA or YRALIS PHRF certificate.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may register online (<https://nyackboatclub.org/event/hryra-last-chance-regatta-1>)

3. FEES

Fees include: trophies, breakfast on Sunday and refreshments (soup or chili) after racing

Entry Fee: \$60.00 (with Hudson River Race)
\$35.00 (stand alone)

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Schedule of events
Sunday, Oct. 9th
Two or more races scheduled
Skippers Meeting: 0830 hrs on the radio (VHF 78)
Warning signal, 1st Race: 0930 hrs
No warning signal after 1230 hrs

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. The sailing instructions will be available by Oct 8th at www.nyackboatclub.org/last-chance. Available on-line only.
- 5.2. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will prevail, changing RRS 63.7.

6. VENUE

- 6.1. The racing area will be that part of the Hudson River known as the Tappan Zee, south of Hook Mountain and north of the Tappan Zee Bridge.

7. THE COURSES

- 7.1. The courses to be sailed will be printed in the Sailing Instructions.

8. SCORING & PRIZES

- 8.1. The regatta will be scored with no throw outs.
- 8.2. Awards will be made to the skippers placing first, second, and third in each class.

9. MOORINGS

- 9.1. A limited number of moorings are available. Please indicate your mooring requirements on the registration form. Good anchoring is available to the north of the Club.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 10.1. Racers shall monitor VHF channel 78 for communications from the Race Committee.
- 10.2. Except in an emergency or notification to the Race Committee, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions while racing that are not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1. Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

- 12.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
