139th ANNUAL OPEN HRYRA REGATTA
Saturday & Sunday, September 9th & 10th, 2023
**** NOTICE OF RACE ****

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The Sailing Instructions will consist of the HRYRA 2023 Common Sailing Instructions (CSI), available for download at the URLs listed in 2.2, and Supplemental Sailing Instructions for this regatta.
- 2.2. The Supplemental Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official notice board and made available for download at the shattemucyc.org/activities/racing and www.HRYRA.org websites prior to the first day of racing. Please print your own copy.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The official notice board is located on the bulletin board just east of the clubhouse entrance.
- 3.2. [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channel 69.
- 3.3. On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio.
- 3.4. [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The regatta is open to all cruising classes that have a currently valid PHRF rating issued by HRYRA or YRALIS.
- 4.2. There will be 3 classes as defined in CSI 6.1 (2 spinnaker, depending on PHRF; 1 non-spinnaker, all PHRFs.)
- 4.3. The Shattemuc racing page at shattemucyc.org/activities/racing#SYCRegatta2023 will have links to on-line registration forms, which indicate how to make payment on line by credit card.
- 4.4. Registrations must be received by 1800 Sept. 8th, or completed at the club on September 9th, 0900-1000.
- 4.5. Late registrations may be accepted by the Race Committee at its discretion.

5. FEES

- 5.1. \$90 (\$85 with US Sailing Member discount); add \$5 if registering after 1800, September 6th. Included: Post race buffet and beer for all boat crew on Saturday; use of pool, when open, for all boat crew; boat berth per NOR 11.1 below.
- 5.2. Mailed checks for on-line registrations must be received by Sept 8, or be hand-delivered on Sat., Sept. 9th.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. Two (2) Races are scheduled for Saturday, first warning signal at 1100; and two (2) races for Sunday, first warning signal at 1030.
- 6.2. For each class, the second race each day will be started as soon as practical after the last finisher of the class's previous race. Multiple sound signals and a VHF announcement will be made prior to the second race's warning signal.
- 6.3. On Sunday, no warning signal will be made after 1415.

7. VENUE

- 7.1. The racing area will be the waters of the Hudson River in the vicinity of Croton Point.

8. THE COURSES

- 8.1. Courses are listed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 8.2. CSI 8.1.2 is changed to be: If a course is intended to be designated as a windward-leeward (W/L) course, its description shall so indicate.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1. The Scoring Penalty will apply as described in CSI 14.

10. SCORING & PRIZES

- 10.1. The regatta will be scored with no throw outs, using time-on-time correction as indicated in CSI 17.
- 10.2. In accordance with the posted notice from YRALIS, PHRF Regulations 2023, paragraph VII Part D, first sentence is changed to be:
D. Windward/Leeward - Commonly abbreviated to W/L, this rating is ONLY for use in races where all legs of the course are substantially parallel and is adjusted to reflect the boats performance in VMG windward/leeward headings with no significant reaching element to the course.
- 10.3. Awards will be made to the skippers and crew placing first and second in each class.

11. BERTHING

- 11.1. Some slips accommodating boats up to 7 foot draft are available for Friday and Saturday night at no charge for yachts registered for the regatta. Please use DOCKWA to make a reservation for a free berth for your boat following the instructions on the on-line registration form.

12. LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk: See RRS 3, "Decision to Race". Shattemuc Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
