## ILSE BIEDERMANN WOMEN'S REGATTA

Saturday, June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025

### \*\* NOTICE OF RACE \*\*

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2. Racing Rule 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: "(2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, and did not see, the incident, or"

#### 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The Sailing Instructions will consist of the HRYRA 2025 Common Sailing Instructions (referred to as CSI) and Supplementary Sailing Instructions that will be posted on the official notice board and made available for download [here](#) by 0900 on Wednesday, June 25, 2025.
- 2.2. The CSI are available for download from the [HRYRA website](#) and the [Shattemuc Yacht Club website racing page](#). Printed copies will not be available.

#### 3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The official notice board is located east of the SYC Clubhouse and notices may also be posted on the SYC racing page, NOR2.1.
- 3.2. [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channel 69.
- 3.3. On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio.
- 3.4. [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that are not available to all boats.

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The regatta is open to all cruising class boats that have a currently valid PHRF rating issued by HRYRA or YRALIS.
- 4.2. There will be 2 classes: Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker, each all PHRFs. This changes CSI 6.1.
- 4.3. The SYC racing page at <https://shattemucyc.org/activities/racing/#ilseB2025> will have links to on-line registration forms, which indicate how to make payment on line by credit card.
- 4.4. Registrations for the regatta must be received by June 25.
- 4.5. Late registrations for the regatta may be accepted by the Race Committee at its discretion.

#### 5. FEES

- 5.1. \$15 for US Sailing Members, \$20 others; add \$5 if registering for the regatta after June 25. Included: racing and use of pool when open for boat crew, berth per additional information below.
- 5.2. Mailed checks for on-line registrations must be received by June 25 or be hand-delivered to the Race Committee on shore on June 28.

#### 6. CREW LIMITATIONS

- 6.1. Each boat shall be skippered, helmed and navigated by a woman. Men may serve as crew members in other roles.

#### 7. SCHEDULE

- 7.1. Races are scheduled for Saturday, June 28, first warning signal at 1030. As many races as practical for the conditions will be sailed.
- 7.2. For each class, the subsequent races will be started as soon as practical after the last finisher of the class's previous race. Multiple sound signals and a VHF announcement will be made prior to the next race's warning signal.
- 7.3. No warning signal will be made after 1530.

#### 8. VENUE

- 8.1. The racing area will be the waters of the Hudson River in the vicinity of Croton Point.

#### 9. THE COURSES

- 9.1. Courses are listed in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

#### 10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1. The Scoring Penalty will apply for breaking a rule of Part 2 of the RRS, as described in CSI 14.

#### 11. SCORING & PRIZES

- 11.1. The regatta will be scored with no throw outs, using time-on-time correction as indicated in CSI 17.
- 11.2. In accordance with the posted notice from YRALIS, PHRF Regulations 2025, paragraph VII Part D, first sentence is changed to be: Windward/Leeward - Commonly abbreviated to W/L, this rating is ONLY for use in races where all legs of the course are substantially parallel and is adjusted to reflect the boats performance in VMG windward/leeward headings with no significant reaching element to the course.
- 11.3. Awards will be made to the skippers placing first if more than 3 registrants, second if more than 6 registrants, and third if more than 9 registrants in each class.

#### 12. LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

- 12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk: See RRS 3, "Decision to Race". Shattemuc Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- a. Slips accommodating boats up to 7 foot draft are available for Friday and Saturday night at no charge for yachts registered for the regatta. Please use DOCKWA to make a reservation for a free berth for your boat following the instructions on the on-line registration form. The DOCKWA code is ilseb25.
- b. Reservations for the Regatta Dinner on Saturday after racing, are \$30 pp (\$5 under 12 yrs) with cash bar and **must be made by 2100, June 24 (Tuesday)**.

D. Windward/Leeward - Commonly abbreviated to W/L, this rating is ONLY for use in races where ~~there are only two marks of the course (windward and leeward)~~ all legs of the course are substantially parallel and is adjusted to reflect the boats performance in VMG windward/leeward headings with no significant reaching element to the course.
