142nd ANNUAL OPEN HRYRA REGATTA

Saturday & Sunday, June 6th & 7th, 2026

** NOTICE OF RACE **

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. The notation "[DP]" is defined on page 1 of the RRS.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The Sailing Instructions will consist of the HRYRA 2026 Common Sailing Instructions (CSI), available for download at the locations listed in 2.2, as amended by Supplementary Sailing Instructions for this regatta.
- 2.2. The Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official notice board and made available for download at the shattemucyc.org/activities/racing and www.HRYRA.org websites prior to the first day of racing. Please print your own copy.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The official notice board is located on the bulletin board just east of the clubhouse entrance.
- 3.2. [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channel 69.
- 3.3. On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio.
- 3.4. [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that are not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The regatta is open to all cruising classes that have a current PHRF certificate issued by HRYRA or YRALIS.
- 4.2. There will be 4 classes as defined in CSI 6.1 (2 spinnaker, depending on PHRF; 1 non-spinnaker, all PHRFs; and a double handed (DH) non-spinnaker class, all PHRFs and with no more than 2 persons aboard.
- 4.3. A special PHRF DH certificate is available upon request from HRYRA (at no charge for boats with a regular certificate) for use only in the double-handed class. A boat may also compete in the DH class using her regular certificate. However, the SAME certificate must be used by the boat for all races in which the boat competes in the DH class. Boats racing in the DH class may use an autopilot while racing.
- 4.4. The Shattemuc racing page at shattemucyc.org/activities/racing#SYCRegatta2026 will have links to on-line registration forms, which indicate how to make payment on line by credit card.
- 4.5. Registrations must be received by 1800 June 5 or completed at the club on June 6, 0900-1000.
- 4.6. Registrations received after June 6 1000 may be accepted by the Race Committee at its discretion.

5. FEES

- 5.1. \$80 (\$75 with US Sailing Member discount); add \$15 if registering after 2359, June 2. Included: Post race BBQ reception reservations for two (additional reservations for BBQ are \$25 plus \$5 if after 2359 June 2); for all crew: continental breakfast Sat and Sun, use of pool when open; boat berth per NoR 11.1.
- 5.2. Payments by check must be received by June 5, or be hand-delivered on Saturday, June 6 by 1000.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. Two (2) Races are scheduled for Saturday, first warning signal at 1100; and two (2) races for Sunday, first warning signal at 1030. Additional races may be started each day at the discretion of the race committee.
- 6.2. For each class, subsequent races each day will be started as soon as practical after the last finisher of the class's previous race.
- 6.3. On Sunday, no warning signal will be made after 1415.

7. VENUE

- 7.1. The racing area will be the waters of the Hudson River in the vicinity of Croton Point.

8. THE COURSES

- 8.1. Courses are listed in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1. The Scoring Penalty will apply as described in CSI 14.

10. SCORING & PRIZES

10.1. The regatta will be scored with no throw outs, using time-on-time correction as indicated in CSI 17.

10.2. In accordance with the posted notice from YRALIS, the [YRALIS Performance Handicap Racing Fleet Regulations, 2026](#), paragraph VII 3.4, first sentence is changed to be:

D. Windward/Leeward - Commonly abbreviated to W/L, this rating is ONLY for use in races where all legs of the course are substantially parallel and is adjusted to reflect the boats performance in VMG windward/leeward headings with no significant reaching element to the course.

10.3. Awards will be made to the skippers and crew placing first and second in each class.

11. BERTHING

11.1. Some slips suitable for boats up to 7 foot draft are available at no charge Friday and Saturday night for boats registered for the regatta. Use DOCKWA to make reservations following instructions on the registration form.

12. LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk: See RRS 3, "Decision to Race". Shattemuc Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
