1 RULES

3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on **78**.

3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The race is open to all members of HRYRA that have a current HRYRA or YRA-LIS PHRF certificate.

4.4 Classes are defined per the HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions.

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

14.1 Appendix T Arbitration will be in effect.

The scoring penalty, rule 44.3, will apply for a violation of a rule of Part 2. The penalty will be the number of places as described in rule 44.3(c).

Rule 44.1 will apply for a violation of rule 31.

For a violation of rule 31, or if a yellow flag is not displayed as required in rule 44.3(a), a boat may instead accept a scoring penalty as described in Rule T1 (see Appendix T of the RRS.)

15 SCORING

15.1 The scoring system is as follows: *PHRF Time-on-Time*.

15.2 *1* race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

18 BERTHING

18.1 A limited number of moorings are available for guests. Submit request via the online registration form. If anchoring, please do so north of the mooring field.

22 RISK STATEMENT

- 22.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**
- 23 INSURANCE
 - 23.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
- 24 PRIZES
 - 24.1 Prizes will be given as follows: *Awards will be made to the skippers placing first, second, and third in each class.*
